New Business

Golf tournament 4/28 at Stoneridge.

Sponsors:

2 free twosomes for each of the 4 team members and buy one-get one free lunches at Prescott club

2 prizes for drawing Each one is a free twosome

Lamb Hole-in-One car package Vehicle to be on display at Stoneridge

AZ hometown radio \$2500 of advertising.

Other items:

- Menu similar as last year. Will do upgraded luncheon again.
- Ball drop ideas to make sure everyone notified of start time. Signs, announcement by starter, and several announcements at lunch.
- Gimme Putt explanation. Cards with definition handed out at registration. Keep price at \$5.00 Only one per golfer.
- Drawing at end. Kay will send Board members copies of event programs for last 2 years which show past prize donors to try again. Don't want to target same people for both the Golf Tournament and the Murder Mystery Dinner.
- Board members need to submit all door prizes to Cheryl by Friday April 12.

Lamb is not a major sponsor - they are just a Hole-in-One sponsor. Show them as a Hole-in-One Sponsor on program. Will be on flyer in order to promote the Hole-in-One.

How have we categorized sponsors in the past? \$2000 and above get name and logo on flyer, and get a free foursome. So far, Arizona's Hometown Radio Group is the only sponsor qualifying for and receiving the free foursome.

Affinity RV usually pays for 4 police officers to play as a foursome. Shows on program as Special Police Foursome Sponsor. Cheryl will see if they want to do more.

Traci presented flyer showing sponsor menu from a Phoenix tournament.

Lora Lee mentioned 2012 State Centennial Committee created menu for donor ships.

In the past, Kay has prepared letters and lists showing sponsorship opportunities for events.

Cheryl asked Traci to prepare a sponsor menu for our tournament.

Cheryl would like major sponsors to be identified and submitted to her by February 4.

Flyers out by mid-February

Board voted and approved the following levels of sponsorship.

- \$2500 get name in all advertising (print, radio, public announcements, etc.), name and logo on event program, display at event, and website listing of sponsors after event. They get Free foursome which includes free lunch.
- \$1250 get name and logo on event program, display day of event, and website listing of sponsors after event. Get free twosome including free lunch
- \$500 get name and logo on event program, display day of event, and website listing of sponsors after event.

Prizes for drawing – get name and logo on event program, display day of event, and website listing of sponsors after event.

Discussion was started about making on-line payments for ease of registering. Need to look further into this.

Preliminary discussion on country dinner dance and /or murder mystery

Discussed how much money Foundation needs to raise each year. Taser payment is about \$37,000. Last year we paid all but \$1800 for Taser payment. We used about $1\frac{1}{2}$ - 2 years of events to do that payment. Historically \$10-15,000 is raised each year.

Discussed whether or not we have the ability to do both the Country Dinner Dance and Murder Mystery Dinner.

Motion was made to do only one event. Approved.

Murder Mystery theme combined with Country Dinner Dance could be a possibility.

Kay had already reserved Stoneridge 8/3 and 10/4 in case we needed it. Reservations need to be made well in advance, even year ahead, in order to get space.

Cheryl tabled the rest of discussion until March meeting.

Traci brought up about linking Facebook to donate for birthday etc. Traci and Marty will look into this and let us know more. Diane will check with Terry Baeseman, our webmaster.
